Rich White

Esk Valley Chardonnay (Hawkes Bay) 9

A classic Hawkes Bay style exhibiting peach, grapefruit and subtle oak nuances. Ideal for fish.

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Viognier (Hawkes Bay) 9

Intensely flavoured, elegant yet approachable. Revealing apricot, quince and exotic spices.

Withers Hills Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough) 9

Vibrant ripe citrus, kaffir lime leaf, fresh coriander and hints of tropical guava.

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough) 9

Vibrant tropical aromas with juicy melon and grapefruit flavours.

Lindauer Brut 200ml 9

Barossa Valley Estate GSM (Barossa, Australia) 9.5

Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre from one of the world's premium wine producing regions.

Light Red

Grasshopper Rock Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 10.5

From the Earnsclough vineyard of Alexandra basin this pinot is ripened in cool temperatures giving it distinct elegance, complexity, finesse and harmony.

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Chardonnay (Hawkes Bay) 40

A good match with a wide range of cuisine, revealing fragrant stone fruits and French oak.

Esk Valley Chardonnay (Hawkes Bay) 40

A classic Hawkes Bay style exhibiting peach, grapefruit and subtle oak nuances. Ideal for fish.

Villa Maria Reserve Barrique Fermented Chardonnay 58

From Gisborne, ripe melon and stone fruit meld with biscuity oak and complex mealy notes.

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Viognier (Hawkes Bay) 40

Intensely flavoured, elegant yet approachable. Revealing apricot, quince and exotic spices.

Wither Hills Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough) 37

Vibrant ripe citrus, kaffir lime leaf, fresh coriander and hints of tropical guava.

Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough) 37

Oyster Bay captures the special character of New Zealand's cool climate viticulture. Elegant, assertive with glorious fruit flavours.

Villa Maria Reserve Clifford Bay Sauvignon Blanc 49

A Marlborough sauvignon featuring powerful and intensely fresh aromas of currants, wild grass and fresh limes.

Esk Valley Pinot Gris (Hawkes Bay) 40

Flavours of baked apple, pear, peach and honey.

Oyster Bay Pinot Gris (Marlborough) 40

A dry style with pear notes, easy drinking.

Grey Ridge Alchemy White Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 42

Aromas of apple and pear, flavours of citrus and white peach with a slightly dry finish. Great for all occasions.

Wooring Tree Blondie Blanc de Noir (Central Otago) 48

Elegant champagne colour. Aromas of nashi pear, feijoa and white peach, with ripe pear, nectarine and a hint of spice on the palate.

Sweet White

Villa Maria Private Bin Gewurztraminer (East Coast) 35

Distinctive aromas of rose petal and lychee, finishing off dry.

Mount Difficulty Gewurztraminer (Central Otago) 55

Picked late to maximise the varietal's inherent aromatic intensity – Lychee and spice characters predominate. The palate has supple tropical fruits with a hint of sweetness and rich oily texture.

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Dry Riesling (Marlborough) 40

Lime and summer blossom aromas with a zesty freshness and subtle spice notes.

Felton Road Riesling (Bannockburn, Central Otago) 60

Off-dry style. With bright acidity and residual sugar combining to produce a uniquely balanced wine.

Bold Red

Barossa Valley Estate GSM (South Australia) 42

Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre from one of the world's premium wine producing regions.

Barossa Valley Estate Shiraz (South Australia) 42

Barossa Valley Estate captures the distinctive elegance and vibrant fruit flavours of a premium wine producing region.

Vidal Reserve Gimblett Gravels Syrah (Hawkes Bay) 47

A deeply coloured Syrah with aromas of black pepper, spice, cherry and florals. A palate displaying intensity and purity of fruit.

Esk Valley Winemakers Reserve Gimblett Gravels Syrah 80

A deeply coloured Hawkes Bay Syrah displaying notes of red fruits, plums, pepper and spice. It is full bodied and rich, but natural acidity so typical of Gimblett Gravels Syrah.

Esk Valley Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon Malbec 40

A full bodied and rich Hawkes Bay blend. Densely coloured, it has a bouquet of dark fruits and subtle oak.

2006 E&E Black Pepper Shiraz (Barossa Valley, Australia) 125

The 2006 vintage exhibits aromas of bright, dark berry fruits, with subtle oak influences. A great example of a Barossa Shiraz.

Medium Red

Villa Maria Cellar Selection Organic Merlot (Hawkes Bay) 40

Aromas of dark plum, savoury cedar spice and dried herb lead to a fleshy palate featuring soft tannins and generous length.

Light Red

Grasshopper Rock Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 49

From the Earnsclough vineyard of Alexandra basin this pinot is ripened in cool temperatures giving it distinct elegance, complexity, finesse and harmony.

Greylands Ridge Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 60

With a lovely ruby colour, a powerful nose of raspberry, strawberry and fruits of the forest.

Two Degrees Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 65

Dark plum and floral flavours are complemented by vanilla, chocolate and spice, balanced tannins and oak. It is ripe and rich with a velvety finish.

Akarua Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 65

Beautifully poised, complex and shows excellent fruit weight supported by fine tannins.

Ceres Composition Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 65

A minimalist winemaking approach. Perfumed red and blackberry fruits with hints of forest floor elements and silky tannins. A good structure and mid-palate mouth feel.

Ata Rangi Pinot Noir (Martinborough) 110

One of New Zealand's premium Pinots. Ata Rangi award winning wines are as good as you will find.

2012 Wooing Tree Sandstorm Reserve Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 110

Especially low yielding hand-picked fruit, gentle winemaking and extended maturation in French oak have resulted in a complex and powerful wine. It has aromas of ripe cherried and plums, a rich and silky smooth palate and a long spicy finish. A great example of one of the best Central Otago pinot noirs.

2012 Ceres Composition Pinot Noir (Central Otago) 80

A minimalist winemaking approach has been used to allow a full expression of the fruit and the vintage. Perfumed red and blackberry fruits with hints of forest floor elements and silky tannins. A good structure and mid-palate mouth feel.

Rosé

Oyster Bay Rosé (Marlborough) 40

Oyster Bay captures the special characters New Zealand's cool climate viticulture... elegant, assertive wines with glorious fruit flavours.

Grey Ridge Horizon Rosé (Central Otago) 42

A crisp and slightly dry Rose made from Pinot Noir grapes. It has complex aromas of white flowers, cranberry and pineapple and on the palate a long persistence with a burst of red and tropical fruits with watermelon combined in a lingering finish.

Champagne & Methode Traditionnelle

Lindauer Brut 200ml 9

A crisp, lively, dryish wine, with gentle nutty, bready characters adding a touch of complexity.

Oyster Bay Sparkling Cuvee Brut (Marlborough) 37

Dry style, easy drinking.

Quartz Reef Methode Traditionelle (Central Otago) 53

Aromas of Royal Gala apples with a hint of lime, flirtatious and moreish on the palate.

Moet & Chandon Champagne (French) 110

"Moet" is synonymous with style, extravagance & decadence.

Bollinger Special Cuvee Champagne (French) 145

Classic French Champagne.
